There will be a vigil Mass on Friday 14th at 7pm and on Saturday 15th at 10am, both in St Patrick's church.

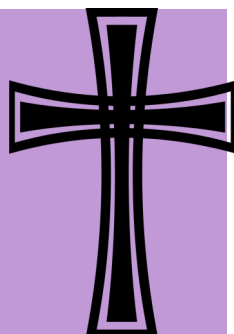
We want to thank all our parishioners who are observing the social distancing regulations at the moment and to all those who are wearing face coverings.
